Standards Australia's Technical Committee IT-014, *Health Informatics*, has successfully concluded its two-year work programme with a total of 41 publications between 2012 and 2014.

The publications include Australian Standards, implementation guides and technical specifications for a range of e-health topics such as telehealth, healthcare concepts, Personally Controlled Electronic Health Records, security, messaging, and clinical decision support.
